### KITTEN CARE PROGRAM

The first six months of your kitten's life can be very enjoyable provided he or she stays happy and healthy. Your kitten can be subjected to a number of problems during this critical phase, most of which can be prevented. This program will cover exam/office call charges, as well as vaccines and treatments listed below during this six month period. This program does not cover extras such as: surgery, x-rays, medications and after hour calls.

- 8 weeks      Comprehensive physical exam, feline leukemia/FIV test, 1<sup>st</sup> FVRCP (distemper, rhinotracheitis, calicivirus and pneumonitis) and deworm for intestinal parasites. Kitten behavior problems, flea and tick prevention and diet recommendations will also be discussed. Your kitten will also receive a complete health record and weight check.
- 12 weeks      Brief exam, 2<sup>nd</sup> FVRCP/1<sup>st</sup> leukemia combination vaccine and fecal exam. Please bring a fresh stool sample.
- 16 weeks      Brief exam, 3<sup>rd</sup> FVRCP/2<sup>nd</sup> leukemia combination vaccine and rabies vaccine. Recommendations on spaying or neutering and basic kitten health care.
